#### Holbrook - Lugnuts Chaperone Information!!

Thank you for offering to chaperone our field trip this Wednesday, May 31.

five between September 2 and December 1; the waiver is included as part of the online pre-enrollment process.

The State of Michigan also requires your child's eyes to be examined at least once after the age of three and before starting school by a licensed eye care practitioner, a medical/osteopathic physician, or the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services.

Upon completion of the pre-enrollment in Registration Gateway, the enrollment documents (see below) must be submitted to the registrar at your home school via:

- Appointment made with the your student's home school
- Mobile Capture (upload from cell phone)
- Direct upload (from a saved file on your device)
- Fax
- Email (not recommended for security purposes)

All of the following enrollment documents are required before information that has been submitted during the online pre-enrollment process can be verified:

- Student's birth certificate with the raised seal
- Student's up-to-date immunization records
- Verification of residency any two of the following:
  - Property Tax Statement
  - Lease/Rental Agreement
  - Utility Bill
  - Mortgage/Home Closing Documents
  - Cable/Internet Bill
  - Home/Renter's Insurance
- Note: Driver's licenses and voter registration cards are NOT acceptable for this purpose.

When all required documentation has been received, you will receive a telephone call to verify the information provided in Registration Gateway and finalize the student enrollment. Did your student have medication in the office this year? Medications must be picked up by June 16.


After this date, medications will disposed of by the district nurse according to policy. **All medications** must be picked up by an adult.

#### **Illness Reminders**




