## IMPORTANT LUGNUT FIELD TRIP INFORMATION - PLEASE READ

### Holbrook - Lugnugs Chaperone Information!!

Thank you for offering to chaperone our field trip this Wednesday, May 31.



Please plan to be in front of the stadium no later than 10:30 to meet the children. You will be given your ticket as well as the tickets for the children in your group. This includes student lunch vouchers.

Chaperones should plan to park behind the Lansing Center in Lot 37. Parking is \$2 per hour. If this lot fills, there is parking garage availability off of Ottawa Street.

You are also welcome to walk around with your group, however, children must be with you at all times and not walking around unsupervised.

Lunch time is up to you and your group and/or teacher.

Although it is supposed to be hot, please do NOT buy your group additional food and drink. There are drinking fountains/filling stations by the restrooms if they would like to refill their lunch cup. Empty water bottles will be allowed to be brought into the stadium for this game only.

We will tell you which bus you will deliver the children to after the game.

Students will be allowed to be signed out after the game by their chaperone. To take your student from Lugnugs Stadium, you must sign him/her out with your child's teacher.

EXTERNAL FOOD AND DRINKS ARE PROHIBITED. LUNCH IS PICKUP ONLY. NO DELIVERIES.



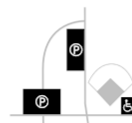
#### BAG POLICY

• Clear plastic, vinyl, or PVC not exceeding 12"x6"x12"  
• One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag (Ziploc bag or similar)  
• Small clutch bag, camera, and binocular cases not exceeding 4.5"x6.5" with or without a handle or strap  
Exceptions made for medically necessary items after proper inspection.

To be eligible to enter kindergarten in the 2023-2024 school year, your child must be five years old on or before September 1, 2023. However, in accordance with State Law, parents may complete a waiver for any student who will turn

five between September 2 and December 1; the waiver is included as part of the online pre-enrollment process.

The State of Michigan also requires your child's eyes to be examined at least once after the age of three and before starting school by a licensed eye care practitioner, a medical/osteopathic physician, or the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services.

Upon completion of the pre-enrollment in Registration Gateway, the enrollment documents (see below) must be submitted to the registrar at your home school via:

- Appointment made with the your student's home school
- Mobile Capture (upload from cell phone)
- Direct upload (from a saved file on your device)
- Fax
- Email (not recommended for security purposes)

All of the following enrollment documents are required before information that has been submitted during the online pre-enrollment process can be verified:

- Student's birth certificate with the raised seal
- Student's up-to-date immunization records
- Verification of residency any two of the following:
  - Property Tax Statement
  - Lease/Rental Agreement
  - Utility Bill
  - Mortgage/Home Closing Documents
  - Cable/Internet Bill
  - Home/Renter's Insurance
- *Note: Driver's licenses and voter registration cards are NOT acceptable for this purpose.*

When all required documentation has been received, you will receive a telephone call to verify the information provided in Registration Gateway and finalize the student enrollment. #### Student Drop Off/Pick Up-

When dropping off your child in the drop off line, please make sure your student is able to exit the vehicle themselves with their belongings, otherwise please park and walk them to the crosswalk.

#### Medication Pick Up


