We would also like to thank the parents who contributed a gift card to show appreciation to the staff. Everyone enjoyed this token of appreciation as well.


Our students will be finishing the standardized testing this upcoming week. We are so proud of their efforts and hard work!



7TH GRADE NEXT FALL - PLEASE READ!

It is hard to believe that your student is almost ready for 7th grade and will be starting at a new school in the fall! The Michigan Public Health Code requires immunizations for all 7th grade students to be reviewed. We wanted to remind families that they should check in before summer ends with their family physician or the Eaton County Health Department to see if your child is up to date on immunizations. State and Local Health Departments requires GLPS to report immunization information for kindergarteners, 7th-graders and student's transferring from other districts. If you do not wish GLPS to report this, completed the form at https://GLcomets.net/

kindergartner future Get your enrolled now! registration and pre-enrollment process for the NEXT SCHOOL YEAR (2023-2024) is now open IF the student you are enrolling lives within the boundaries of Grand Ledge Public Schools. Please enroll your child in kindergarten by starting the process at GLcomets.net/Enroll. Enroll now so that you can sign up for a Parent Meeting on May 16 or May 24. Enroll now to sign up for Kindergarten Launch on Aug. 15 & 16.

The State of Michigan also requires your child's eyes to be examined at least once after the age of three and before starting school by a licensed eye care practitioner, a medical/osteopathic physician, or the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services.

Upon completion of the pre-enrollment in Registration Gateway, the enrollment documents (see below) must be submitted to the registrar at your home school via:

• Appointment made with the your student's home school
• Mobile Caturue (upload from cell phone)
• Direct upload (from a saved file on your device)
• Fax
• Email (not recommended for security purposes)

- All of the following enrollment documents are required before information that has been submitted during the online pre-enrollment process can be verified:


 Student's birth certificate with the raised seal

 Student's up-to-date immunization records

 Verification of residency any two of the following:

 Property Tax Statement
- - Lease/Rental Agreement
- Uelity Bill
 Mortgage/Home Closing Documents
 Cable/Internet Bill
 Home/Renter's Insurance
 Driver's licenses and voter registration cards are NOT acceptable for this purpose.

When all required documentation has been received, you will When all required documentation has been received, you will receive a telephone call to verify the information provided in Registration Gateway and finalize the student enrollment. 
