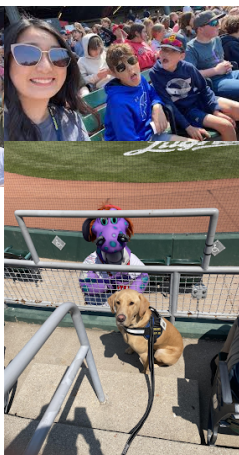

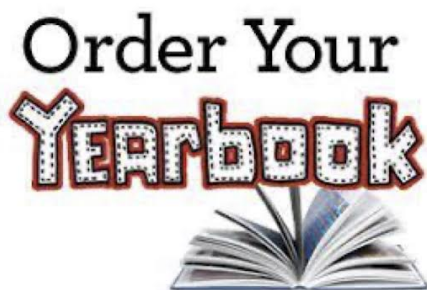

7TH GRADE NEXT FALL

It is hard to believe that your student is almost ready for 7th grade and will be starting at a new school in the fall! The Michigan Public Health Code requires immunizations for all 7th grade students to be reviewed. We wanted to remind families that they should check in before summer ends with their family physician or the Eaton County Health Department to see if your child is up to date on immunizations. State and Local Health Departments requires GLPS to report immunization information for kindergarteners, 7th-graders and student's transferring from other districts. If you do not wish GLPS to report this, completed the form at <https://GLcomets.net/DenyDisclosureToHealthDepartments> and give it to your school office before October 6, 2023.
