ENRICHMENT HIGHLIGHT - STEAM WITH MRS. SHORT

STEAM class allows students to engage collaboratively in applying their knowledge of Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math through various problem-based learning opportunities. Students are empowered to be curious learners who seek creative solutions to problems using the engineering design process. This exploratory class helps students to take risks, persevere and become resilient problem solvers, and learn how to collaborate with others. Our most recent challenge consisted of students building a roller coaster out of materials found around school or at home. MUD ALERT! BRING EXTRA CLOTHES! LOST & FOUND



YEARBOOK INFORMATION

The yearbooks for Hayes will be delivered later this spring. We will have a yearbook signing party day during the last week of school

Most of the photograph packages come with a yearbook. If you did not order a yearbook for your child in their package you can still order a yearbook online at qeskusphoto.com/yearbookorders

It is hard to believe that your student is almost ready for 7th grade and will be starting at a new school in the fall! The Michigan Public Health Code requires immunizations for all 7th grade students to be reviewed. We wanted to remind families that they should check in before summer ends with their family physician or the Eaton County Health Department to see if your child is up to date on immunizations. State and Local Health Departments requires GLPS to report immunization information for kindergarteners, 7th-graders and student's transferring from other districts. If you do not wish GLPS to report this, completed the form at https://GLcomets.net/DenyDisclosureToHealthDepartments and give it to your school office before October 6, 2023.

Kindergarten Registration: **Enroll Now to Sign Up for** Your Parent Meeting & Kindergarten Launch

Get your future kindergartner enrolled now! The online registration and pre-enrollment process for the NEXT SCHOOL YEAR (2023-2024) is now open IF the student you are enrolling lives within the boundaries of Grand Ledge Public Schools. Please enroll your child in kindergarten by the starting process at GLcomets.net/Enroll. Enroll now so that you can sign up for a Parent Meeting on May 16 or May 24. Enroll now to sign up for Kindergarten Launch on Aug. 15 & 16.



o be eligible to enter kindergarten in the 2023-2024 school har, your child must be five years old on or before ptember 1, 2023. However, in accordance with State Law, ments may complete a waiver for any student who will turn we between September 2 and December 1; the waiver is included as part of the online pre-enrollment process.

The State of Michigan also requires your child's eyes to be examined at least once after the age of three and before starting school by a licensed eye care practitioner, a medical/osteopathic physician, or the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services.

Upon completion of the pre-enrollment in Registration Gateway, the enrollment documents (see below) must be submitted to the registrar at your home school via:

Appointment made with the your student's home school

Mobile Capture (upload from cell phone)

Pierc tupload (from a saved file on your device)

All of the following enrollment documents are required before information that has been submitted during the online pre-enrollment process can be verified:

- Student's birth certificate with the raised seal

- Student's up-to-date immunization records

- Verification of residency any two of the following:

- Property Tax Statement

- Lease/Rental Agreement

- Utility Bill

- - Utility Bill
 Mortgage/Home Closing Documents
 Cable/Internet Bill
- Home/Renter's Insurance
 Driver's licenses and voter registration cards are NOT acceptable for this purpose.

When all required documentation has been received, you will When all required documentation has been received, you will receive a telephone call to verify the information provided in Registration Gateway and finalize the student enrollment. 





