A. LEADERSHIP & RESILIENCY PRESENTATION

GLHS Dean of Students Maria Capra, Student Success Coordinator Warren Lester, and Comet Pride Officer Chris Chester provided the board with an overview of the In-School Probation Program. They provided the rational behind the program, the history of the program, what the program is, how the program works, reviewed the Leadership and Resiliency Program that is part of the ISPP, the number of students served since inception, types of offenses that can result in referral to the program, success rate over the course of the program, and the goals of the ISPP.

Harriett Dean commended the district for getting ahead of the issue and noted she uses the GLPS ISPP as a model for two other districts that she oversees.

It was noted that more training for the staff on this program would be of great benefit.
