# **Transition to Holbrook Elementary for Grades K-4**

Remodel 8 outdated classrooms & add 8 new classrooms. Add & remodel for a secure entry, add multipurpose room, mechanical & electrical system upgrades for efficiency, upgrade fire alarm system, technology infrastructure upgrades, create separate parking & drives for parents & buses.



# **Transition to Wacousta Elementary for Grades K-4**

\$20,262,042

Replace existing inefficient, open-plan building with a new elementary school. Equip & furnish the facility, provide additional playgrounds (Dream Depot 2.0 remains untouched!), create separate parking & drives for parents & buses. Demolish the existing facility.



#### **Transition to Willow Ridge Elementary for Grades K-4**

Add & remodel for secure entry, add 2 classrooms & multipurpose room, mechanical & electrical system upgrades for efficiency, upgrade fire alarm system, technology infrastructure upgrades, repave existing lots, improve traffic flow.



### **Transition to Hayes Intermediate School for Grades 5-6**

\$9,321,519

Add & remodel for a secure entry, partial roof replacement, mechanical & electrical system upgrades for efficiency, upgrade fire alarm system, technology infrastructure upgrades, repave existing lots, provide separate bus loop around the back of the building, improve traffic flow.



#### **Transition to Beagle Middle School for Grades 7-8**

\$22,576,443



Construct a new agricultural vocational building that includes classrooms, large bay area, support spaces, building utilities, parking & drives.




#### **Transportation Improvements**
