### **Good News - Student Achievement**

Over 50 graduates were A.P. Scholars, scoring 3+ on three or more Advanced Placement Exams (earning college credit)

1 in 4 graduates had scored a 3+ on at least one A.P. Exam

Our district's financial stability continues to improve!

- For the first time in 20 years, this district will not "borrow" money to meet payroll this fall.
- Saving the district thousands of dollars in interest payments, from \$50,000 to \$120,000

### Making More Good News in the Future!

On August 13, the Board of Education approved placing two (stand alone) bond proposals on the November 6, 2018 ballot.

- Proposal 1 Smarter, Stronger, Safer Schools
- Proposal 2 Community, Athletic, & Fine Arts

### Proposal 1 - Smarter, Stronger, Safer Schools








- District's grade restructuring initiative
- Additional classrooms
- Technology for students & staff
- Upgrade critical needs
- Increase operational efficiencies
- Provide secure entrances at all schools
- Improve traffic flow
- Busses to replace aging bus fleet

### Proposal 2 - Community, Athletics, & Fine Arts

- Improve fine arts spaces at the High School by adding lobby and support spaces
- Construct a new pool at Beagle (secondary school campus)
- Construct walking track and weight room in old pool area for community and athletic uses
- Improve athletic fields at the "22 acres"



### Why a bond? Where we are & how we got here...

#### • 2009/2010 Crisis

- Grand Ledge Public Schools lost \$470/student
- \$2.4 Million Annual Reduction!!!
  - Closed Greenwood Elementary (reopened as City Hall)
  - Closed Holbrook Elementary (currently Early Childhood Center)
  - Closed Sawdon Alternative High School (students and staff absorbed @ GLHS)

#### • 2010 - the District restructured to the following to survive crisis

- Neff Kindergarten Center
- Beagle, Delta Center, Wacousta, & Willow Ridge: 1-6
- Hayes: 7-8
- GLHS: 9-12

### Listening to the Community!

- Focus Groups
  - Input from students, parents, staff, & community
- Community Survey
  - Over 3,000 responses
- Analyzed Feedback to Create Bond Proposals

### **Restructuring for Our Future**

If bond passes, the district plans to begin new structure in the 2020-2021 school year.

- Neff & Delta Mills: Early Childhood Centers
- Holbrook: K-4
- Wacousta: K-4
- Willow Ridge: K-4
- Delta Center: K-4
- Hayes Intermediate: 5-6
- Beagle Middle School: 7-8
- Grand Ledge High School: 9-12
- Dave & Betty Morris School Building: agricultural / vocational / STEAM building

### **Restructuring for Our Future**

- Reduce the size (# of students) of elementary buildings
- More appropriately group students based on their development
- Bring the kindergartners <u>home</u>, back to their local elementary
- Provide opportunities for gifted & talented programs at the 5-6 Intermediate School
- Departmentalization of teaching, special facilities, and equipment
  - i.e., science labs, technology labs, band, and choir classes/rooms
- Provide opportunities for HS classes for Beagle MS students
- This plan would enable the Intermediate and Middle Schools to develop extracurricular activities and to provide experiences and leadership specifically for early adolescents.
- Additionally, research suggests that younger children are less intimidated by schoolmates who are no more than four years older than them. This can help to reduce bullying.

### Bond 2018 - "What's this going to cost?!?"

#### Proposal 1 - Smarter - Stronger - Safer - Schools

- Approximately .89 mill increase over the prior year's debt millage rate
- Provide \$118,640,000 for three-phase project, ten-year plan

#### Proposal 2 - Community - Athletics - Fine Arts

- Approximately .55 mill increase over the prior year's debt millage rate
- Provide \$29,485,000 for one-phase project

### Bond 2018 - "What's this going to cost me?!?"

Increased cost over the prior year to property owners for **Proposal** 







### **Delta Center K-4 School**
































### **Dave & Betty Morris Vocational Building**
